The Winter 2008 **AGH *film* series** welcomes special guest **Piers Handling**, Director of the Toronto International Film Festival as he introduces a screening of Jean-Luc Godard's classic **Two or Three Things I Know About Her**, with a post-screening question and answer period on **Wednesday, April 16 at 7:00 pm** at the Empire Jackson Square 6 Cinemas, 2 King Street West, downtown Hamilton.

In French New Wave pioneer Jean-Luc Godard's 1966 rumination of life in the material world, the "her" of the title is Paris in the midst of urban renewal, but "she" is also a loving mother and suburban housewife forced into part-time prostitution to make ends meet. This film is revolutionary, impudent and personal, but still stops to admire the sublime in the ordinary: birth, death and infinity in the swirl of a coffee cup. Rated R.

Piers Handling is Director and CEO of the *Toronto International Film Festival Group* (TIFFG), one of the world's most vibrant cultural organizations. During his tenure, he has overseen major expansions of the TIFFG's initiatives including *Reel Talk* and *Cinematheque Ontario* and the creation of *Sprockets: The Toronto International Film Festival for Children* and *Film Circuit*, which provides films to communities across Canada.
