AGH i love film series
Cave of Forgotten Dreams
screened in 3D

Art Gallery of Hamilton's *ilovefilm* series final film of 2011 is the awe-inspiring documentary **Cave of Forgotten Dreams**, shown in 3D, on **Wednesday, December 7 at 7 pm** at the Empire Jackson Square 6 Cinemas, 2 King Street Street West, Hamilton. Complimentary 3D glasses will be provided upon entering the theatre.

Cave of Forgotten Dreams is the BMO Bank of Montreal Audience Choice Award - 2011 film from the AGH CIBC Wood Gundy World Film Festival. Festival-goers selected **Cave of Forgotten Dreams** from the 40 films screened during the 10-day Festival.

Regular film tickets are \$6.00 for AGH Members (including Student Access participants), \$8.00 for students and seniors and \$10.00 for adults. The AGH *ilovefilm* series Pass (offering ten tickets per pass and valid for a year from date of purchase) is \$54.00 for AGH Members, \$72.00 for students and seniors and \$90.00 for adults. Tickets and passes may be purchased online in advance at www.artgalleryofhamilton.com, in person at the AGH during Gallery hours or at the screening venue 30 minutes prior to start time.

Having gained unprecedented access through the tightest of restrictions and overcome considerable technical challenges, Werner Herzog has captured on film the interior of the Chauvet Cave in southern France. This is where the world's oldest cave paintings – hundreds in number - were discovered in 1994. The film reveals to us a breathtaking subterranean world and leads us to the 32,000-year-old artworks. In that deeply moving moment of encounter, we come face to face with pristine and astonishingly realistic drawings of horses, cattle and lions, which for the briefest second come alive in the torchlight. In true Herzogian fashion, his hypnotically engaging narration weaves in wider metaphysical contemplations as we learn more about the Paleolithic art and its creators.
