Mixing interviews, news footage and dramatic recreations, the film provides an unflinching look at the gross injustices suffered by these men at the hands of American and British soldiers, spending 2 years in prison without being charged of a crime. Directed by Michael Winterbottom and Mat Whitecross, ***The Road To Guantanamo*** was the winner of the Silver Bear, Berlin International Film Festival
