The **AGH film series** is pleased to screen Federico Fellini's most personal masterpiece, ***Juliet of the Spirits*** on **Wednesday, June 10 at 7:00 pm** at the **Art Gallery of Hamilton**, 123 King Street West, downtown Hamilton.

Special to the evening is guest speaker Franco Gallippi, Professor of Italian language and literature, McMaster University. Admission includes a post-screening wine and cheese reception.

This Italian film classic was Fellini's first feature in colour. Bored Italian housewife Giulietta (played by Fellini's wife, Giulietta Masina) faces the ennui of life, a philandering husband, and the odd lifestyle of her sexy neighbour, Suzy. As Giulietta taps into her desires and demons, she gains more self-awareness and — ultimately — independence. **1966 Golden Globe Winner, Best Foreign Film.**
