Directed by Je-gyu Kang, **Tae Guk Gi** (South Korea, 2004) tells the story of one Korean family set against the backdrop of war. After independence, Korea is full of hope for a better future and the family of Jin-tae is no different. Focusing on educating his younger brother Jin-Seok, Jin-tae and his family work together to raise money for Jin-Seok's university tuition. Their dreams of a better life are crushed when the Korean War breaks out and both brothers are drafted to the front line. With war and death surrounding them, Jin-tae decides that he must, at any cost, save his brother – his family's one hope for prosperity.
