COVID-19 GUIDELINES

The following measures will be in place to ensure your visit is stress free and safe:

- Sanitize your hands at the stations provided.
- Plexiglass shields have been installed at Visitor Services and at the Shop at AGH.
- All high contact surfaces will be disinfected regularly.
- Elevators have an occupancy limit of 2 people, physically distanced, or one household unit at a time. The North Stairwell will be available for use as an alternative.
- Each washroom will have a capacity limit posted near the entrance. Some stalls have been closed.
- Pay attention to floor markers and signage throughout the building.
- Personal protective equipment is required, and masks will be available at Visitor Services should you require one.

Recommended traffic flow and Gallery capacity is shown on the Gallery Map.

Visitors will be required to maintain a physical distance of 6 feet (2 metres) while in the Gallery. If a Gallery space is full and you are unable to maintain the required distance, please visit a different Gallery space until there is room for you to enter safely.

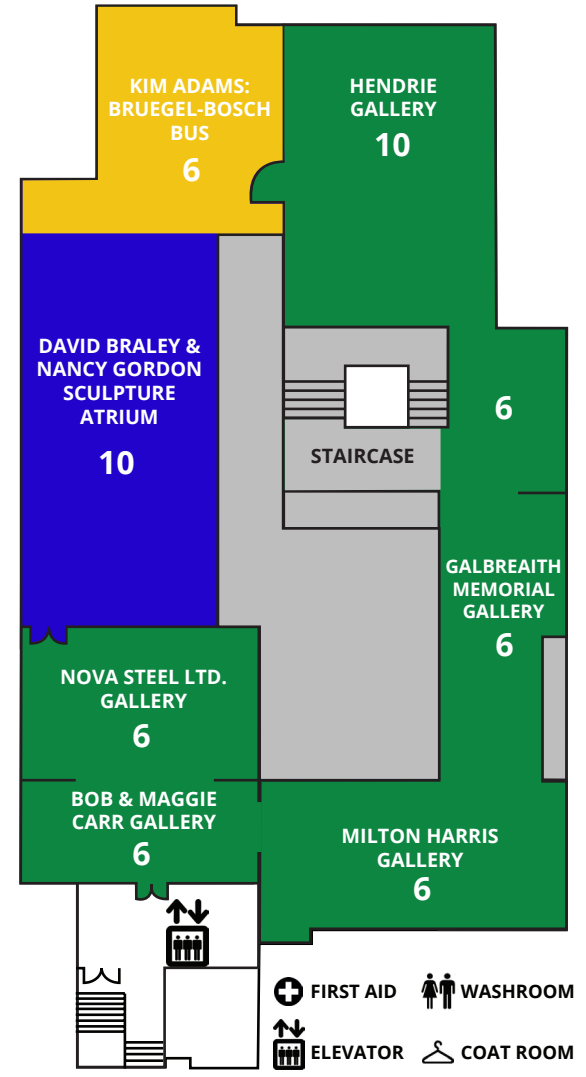
