The Gallery delivers exhibitions accompanied by a range of programs and activities geared to encourage access, promote education, and inspire discussion among increasingly diverse audiences both in the immediate region and beyond. Our current and projected exhibition program foregrounds a diverse representation of art and artists from the region. We encourage global conversations by situating regional practices within broader social, cultural and political discussions.

AGH Art Sales + Services is a not-for-profit program operated by the Art Gallery of Hamilton (AGH) to support local artists, public programming, and community education. Representing over 70 local and regional artists, the program offers artwork for purchase and rental and hosts an annual Art Sale event.

The AGH is seeking a highly organized and detail-oriented Art Consultant to manage artwork inventory, database and website maintenance, e-commerce operations, and support sales and the AGH Art Sale.

Key responsibilities include maintaining the art inventory, updating records in Salesforce, and ensuring the e-commerce (Shopify) site and AGH website remain current. The Consultant will track artwork locations, manage client and artist records, and oversee interdepartmental sales reporting. They will also maintain artist agreements, bios, and promotional materials, ensuring clear communication and best practices. The Consultant will answer sales inquiries and support sales consultations by phone, email and in person.

During the AGH Annual Art Sale, responsibilities intensify with the coordination of artwork drop-off, installation, dismantling, logistics and client assistance.

The ideal candidate has experience in art sales, gallery operations, e-commerce, or luxury retail, along with strong organizational and database management skills. This role requires on-site work, the ability to lift 25 lbs, and a valid driver's license.

The role is a 12-month full-time contract position (35 hours per week), with occasional evenings and weekends. Salary range for this role is \$40,000-\$44,000, plus competitive benefits and vacation.
