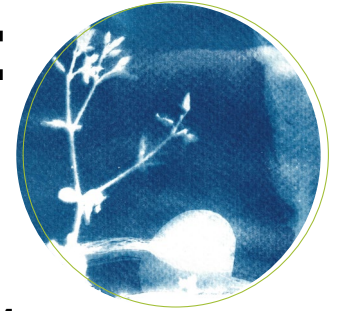

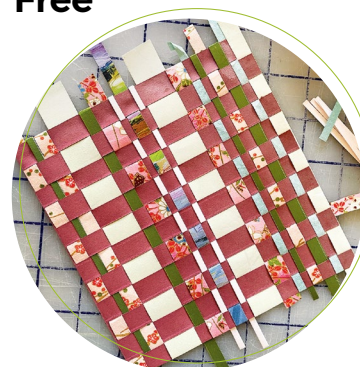

Nocturne is an immersive after-hours experience that transforms the Gallery through live performance. Wander into a world of aerialists, dancers, theatrical characters and musicians. Watch the magic unfold around you before the evening builds toward its main show.

Featuring artists from **Hamilton Aerial Group** and **Spindle Collective**, alongside **Emma Whale**, **Sophie Bonifaz**, **Mayumi Lashbrook / Aeris Körper**, **Lor Lacambra**, **Liz Worth**, **Julia Garlisi**, **Priyanka Tope** and **Vanessa Ramirez**, Nocturne brings together artists from across disciplines for a night that sparks the imagination. After the performance, stay late as **DJ Savage Good** takes over and turns the Pavilion into an after-party.

Gather in the Pavilion for an immersive performance bringing together circus arts, dance, live music, spoken word, and visual spectacle.

After the Show — DJ Savage Good

The performance ends, but the night doesn't. Stay for drinks, music, and dancing as **DJ Savage Good** closes out Nocturne.

Who gets to call a city home and what happens when housing becomes an investment instead of a human right?

Presented by the **Art Gallery of Hamilton** in partnership with the **Hamilton Burlington Society of Architects (HBSA)** and **Young Architects of Hamilton (YAH)**, this special screening of director **Fredrik Gertten's** acclaimed documentary **PUSH** looks at the forces making cities increasingly unaffordable to the people who live in them. Following Leilani Farha, former UN Special Rapporteur on the Right to Housing, the film travels across cities and continents to investigate the financialization of housing and the growing divide between housing as a home and housing as a commodity.

More than a night at the movies, the evening invites audiences to consider these questions through the lens of our own communities, with a panel discussion bringing the conversation closer to home.

Watch Fredrik Gertten's documentary exploring the global housing crisis and the forces changing who can afford to live in our cities.

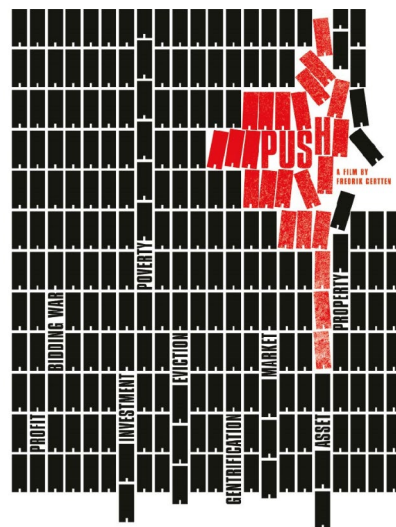
